

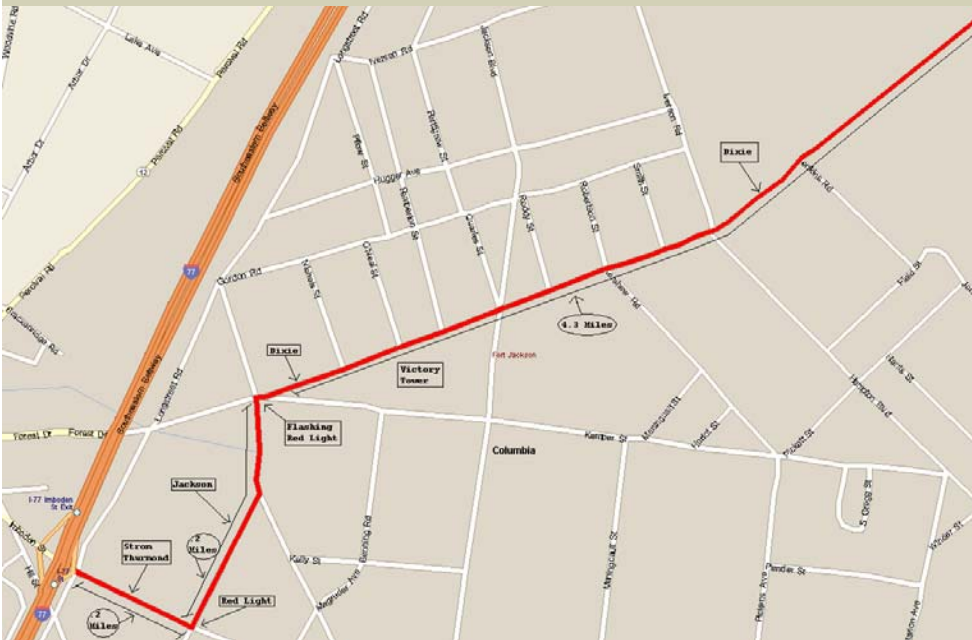
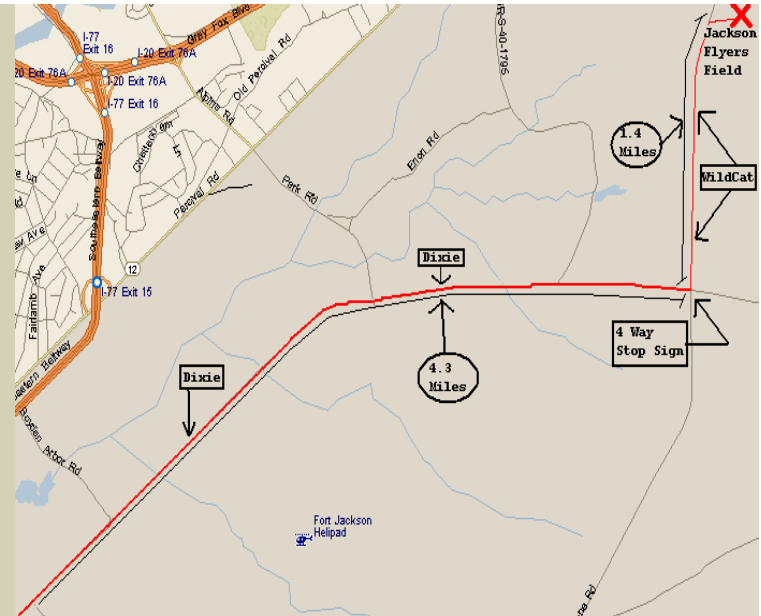
**Enter Ft. Jackson at (Forest Drive exit 12 off of I-77).
(Drivers License, Vehicle Registration, & Insurance card required)**

Turn left on Jackson Blvd. (Second red light) Go about .2 miles

Turn right on Dixie (Flashing red light) (You are on the right track if you pass the “Victory Tower” on the right) (Go 4.3 miles, passing a little abandon guard shack in the middle of the road with a flashing green light, then you will pass the training ranges)

Turn left on Wildcat Road (4 way stop) Go 1.4 miles

Jackson Flying Field is on the right, just past a concrete roadway that crosses Wildcat.
